Vision: "Liberate to Empower"

Mission: "Promotion and well being of individuals, families and society based on the values of justice, fellowship and freedom"

Objectives:

- Empowering the Powerless, including the excluded and giving the best to the least irrespective of caste and creed.
- To provide every disabled person with services aimed at preventing appearance of possible disabling conditions and to give all necessary treatment to develop the remaining abilities to the highest possible level.
- To address the issues and problems of Disabled, Orphans, Semi-orphans Child laborers, Children deserted by parents, HIV/AIDs parents children in our work areas through comprehensive awareness education and rehabilitation programs.
- To identify the potential parents and relatives and give awareness education to them on child care and child rights.
- To enhance the social responsibility of the parents and villagers especially the village committee
- To redeem and re-school the child laborers
- To give family counseling to the potential people
- To in still in the minds of the children Self Esteem and Confidence and give up all thoughts of self pity.
- To give greater importance on health education, awareness programs by way of family visits, group discussions, orientation training, camps and public meetings.
- To eradicate every disease by means of preventive and promotive rather than curative measures.
- To give value and life education, skills training, income generation activities and educate them to make use of available resources in order to raise their standard of living.

4. Background of the Organisation:

ANBU ILLAM means an ABODE OF LOVE.

Anbu Illam is a registered Trust under the patronage of Our Lady of the Poor. It was a DREAM & a VISION of Miss. Yvonne BASSEVILLE, a French lady who lived in India for 30 years committed to the cause of the poor, disadvantaged and marginalized section of the society especially the leprosy affected, the physically and mentally challenged. In 1985 she purchased about 5.5 acres of land in the outskirts of Salem, in a village called



Nattamangalam, 10 km from the District Head quarters. As she was fully involved in the social action ministry, she came to realize and recognize the urgent need of " including the excluded " and formed a Trust (Our Lady of the poor charitable Trust) to have a rehabilitation centre for them. As she was continuing this noble task, due to advancing age and failing health, Miss. Yvonne and other Trustees realized their inability to devote time and energy to continue the activities of the Trust and they decided to handover the Trust to someone who can continue. So they approached and requested the Sisters of St. Joseph of Cluny. After a thorough study and discernment, with the permission of the local Ordinary – the Bishop, in consultation with our Major Superiors, we, the Cluny sisters began to function with added vigour and creativity with renewed DREAMS and VISIONS from July 4th 1996 under the same Trust expanding the activities according to the signs of the times.

5. Population being served by your Organisation:

20000 to 50000 people of different category (men, women, youth &children) (Differently Abled, orphans, semi-orphans, school going, child labourers, prisoners and their children, HIV/AIDs parents & children – positive, negative, Tuberculosis affected & infected. People below poverty line, slum dwellers, the most vulnerable, Aged, etc.
